

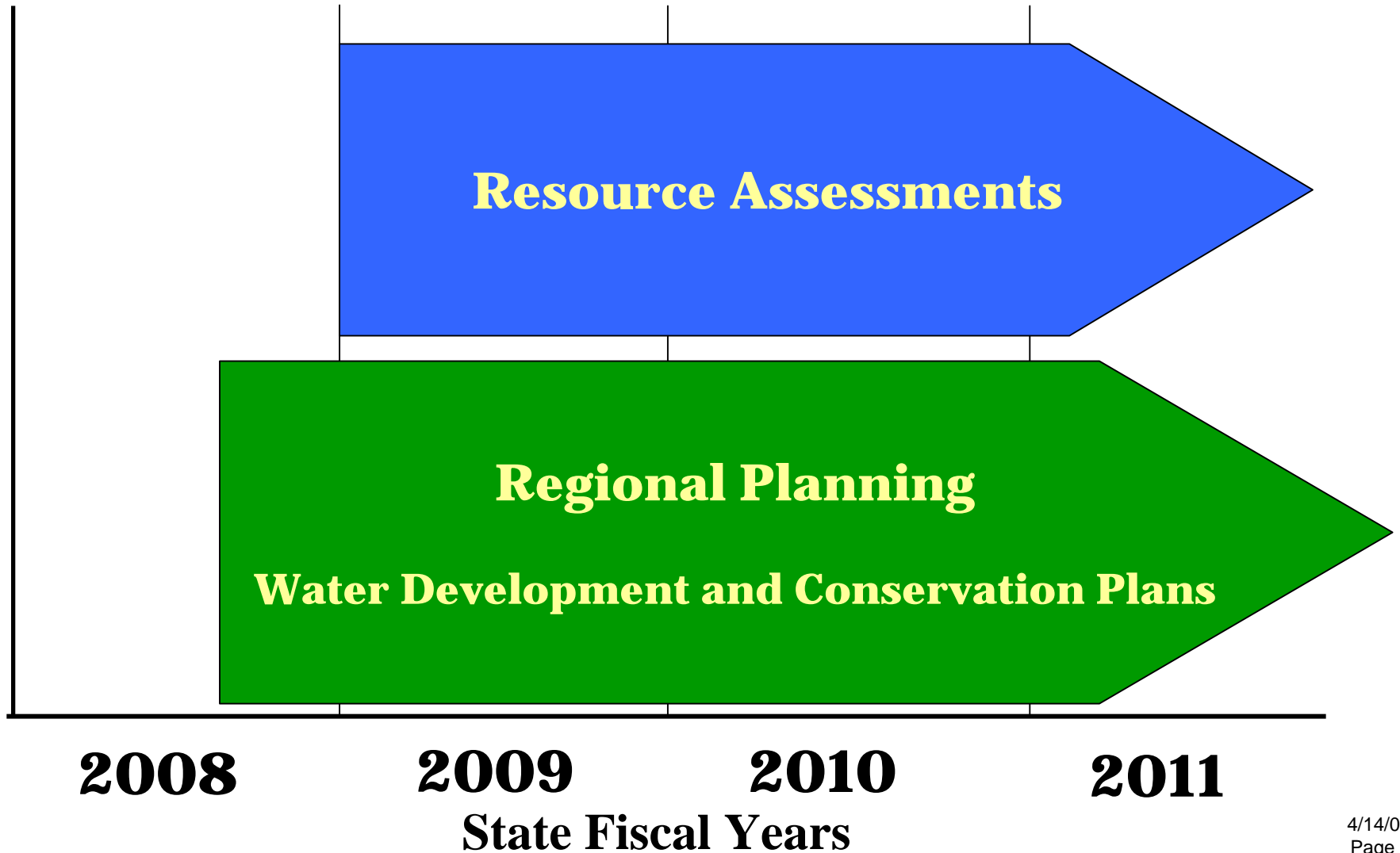

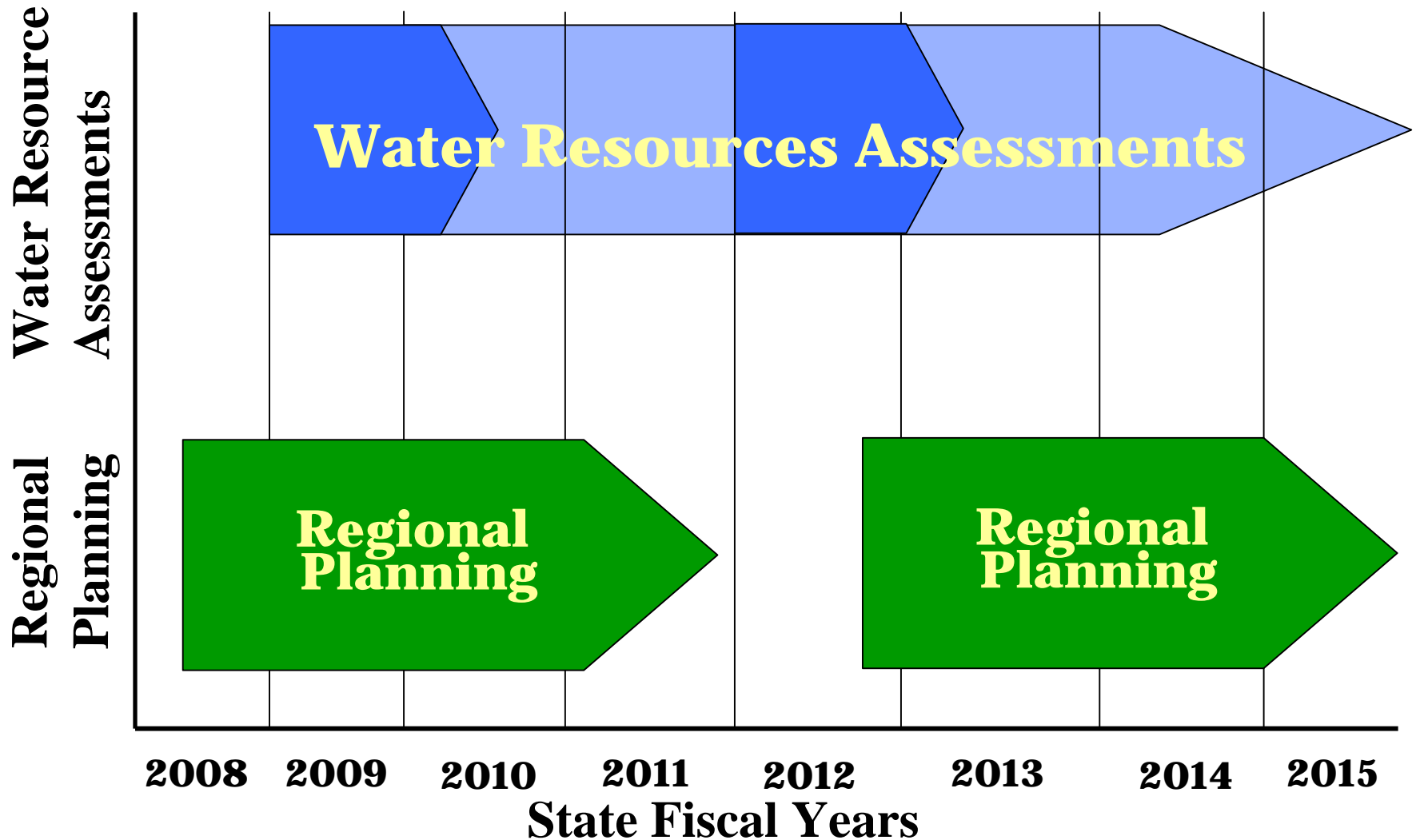


# State Water Plan Implementation





# Phased Implementation of Water Plan





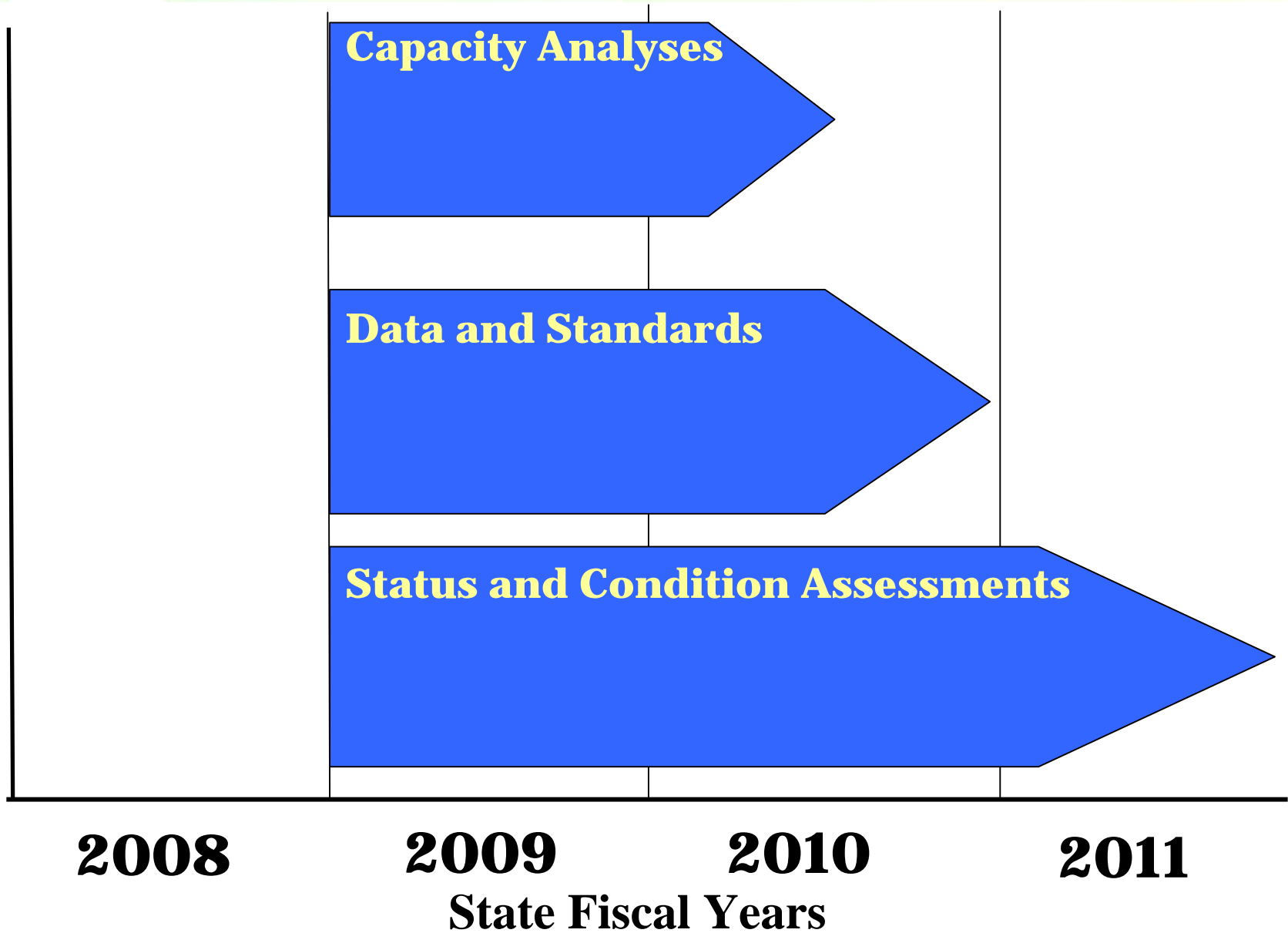
